Speaker : Gan Chong Chieh

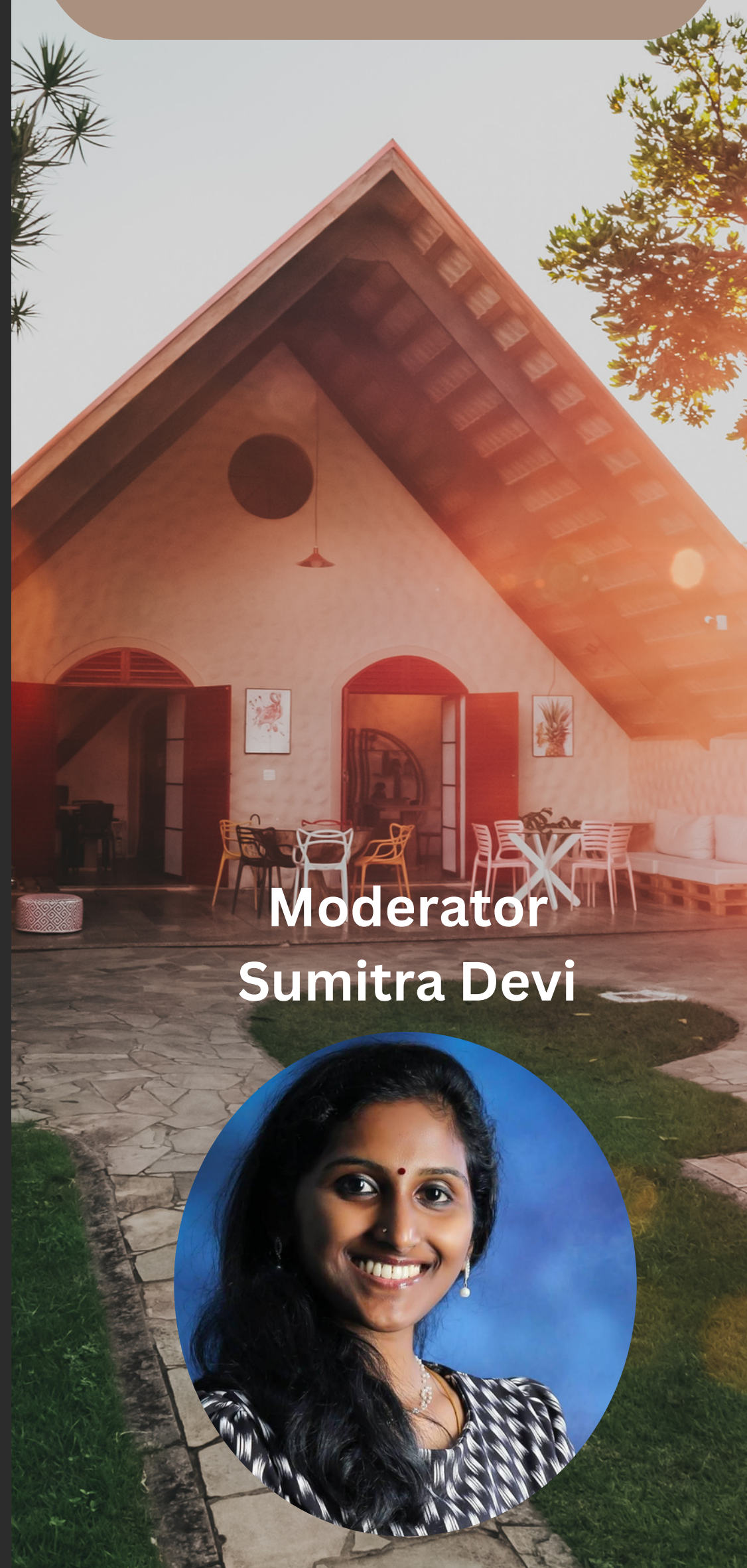
Gan graduated with a Bachelor of Laws (Hons) from the University of London (External) in 2007 and completed his Certificate of Legal Practice in 2008. He chambered under Dato' Mah Weng Kwai and was admitted as an Advocate and Solicitor of the High Court of Malaya in September 2009. Gan was made a partner of the firm in March 2019. Gan obtained a Masters of Laws in International Economic Law from the East China University of Political Science and Law (ECUPL) under a scholarship of the Chinese Ministry of Education in 2017. He also heads the firm's ASEAN-China Desk for inbound and outbound investments.

Gan practices in the area of dispute resolution with a focus on estate administration and commercial litigation. AsiaLaw Profiles ranks Gan as a Rising Star in Dispute Resolution. Gan was the finalist for the Dispute Resolution Lawyer of the Year at the ALB Malaysia Law Awards in 2023 and the finalist for the Young Lawyer of the Year at the ALB Malaysia Law Awards in 2021 and 2024.

Gan has authored the 'Annotated Statutes of Malaysia - Persons with Disabilities Act 2008', 'Contempt of Court in Malaysia: Practice and Procedure', and updated the editions of 'Atkin's Court Forms Malaysia' for both Evidence and Probate.
