On 8–9 August 2025, the MyBar Games were successfully hosted and organised in Kuala Lumpur. Selangor Bar delivered an outstanding performance, maintaining our position as Overall First Runner-Up among all participating state bars.

Pickleball was introduced as an inaugural sport at this year's MyBar Games in Kuala Lumpur. For the first time, Selangor Bar sent a total of 196 players, a significant increase compared to 120 participants last year.

The introduction of Pickleball an increasingly popular and well-received sport contributed to the surge in participation. The record turnout from Selangor Bar was further driven by overwhelming member response, strong camaraderie among participants, the introduction of an accommodation subsidy by the Bar Council, and the overall positive engagement from members.
