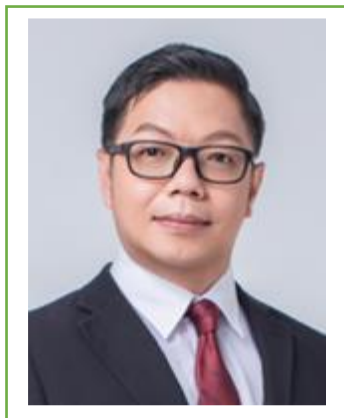

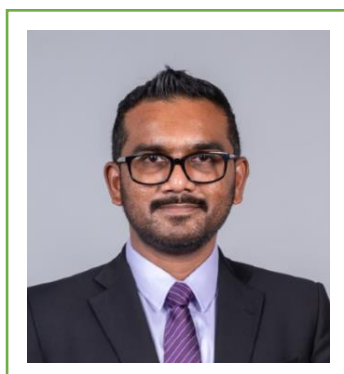

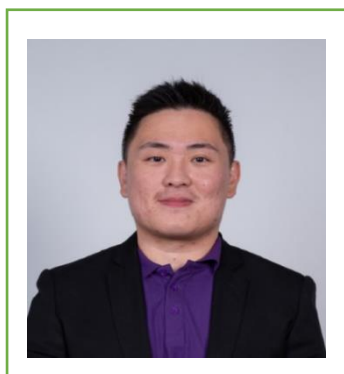

Selangor Bar Fraternity Dining 2026

The 4th Selangor Bar Fraternity Dining 2026 took place on 23 January 2026 at Kelab Golf Negara Subang (KGNS) and was attended by 60 participants, comprising members of the Judiciary, pupils, young lawyers and senior members of the Bar. The lecture and dining session was designed to emulate the tradition of the “12 dinners”, now known as the Qualifying Sessions, as held by the English Inns of Court. Pupils' Introductory & Interview Session

Every pupil is required to attend a mandatory Introductory Session organised monthly by the Young Lawyers & Pupils Sub-committee. The session begins with a briefing by the Legal Aid Centre, which covers the legal aid service, followed by a session conducted by the Co-Chairpersons of the Young Lawyers & Pupils Sub-Committee. The pupils are briefed on the filing of petitions, the Introduction Form, Referee Form, Particulars of Petitioner's Form, the mandatory four (4) CPD talks organised by the Selangor Bar Committee, professional ethics and etiquette, court decorum and attire, duties to the courts and clients, the and other relevant matters. Thereafter, the pupils present are "interviewed" by the Committee Members in attendance. The pupils are also given the opportunity to ask questions concerning their pupillage and practice. The Committee Members shared their experience and knowledge with the pupils. We trust that the pupils have gained valuable guidance and advice from the session. The sessions were interactive, engaging, and educational.

In this term, approximately 30 pupils were admitted as Advocates and Solicitors of the High Court of Malaya at Shah Alam.
