

“VARIATION WORKS: ORIGINAL WORK SCOPE AND POWER TO VARY”



Ascertaining whether or not there was a variation to the works is sometimes difficult, due to ambiguity about what was the original work scope. There may be conflicting requirements stated in the contract. Or “invisible” obligations implied by law. Also, the contractual power to vary the works is not absolute; there are unseen underlying boundaries at play.
